Dr. Faleh is Assistant for Policy to the Minister of Health, at the Supreme Council of Health (SCH), Qatar's highest health authority.



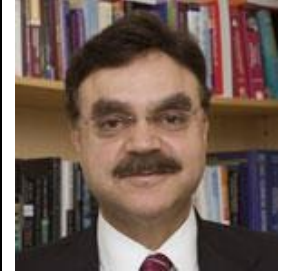
Dr. Hisham Aljadhey
